Supervisor Homan gave an update on Tourism and stated that he also has attended meetings virtually. Supervisor Wedemeyer gave an update on Zion, the Landfill, and DECAT. Supervisor Hoadley gave an update on Emergency Management and Crossroads. Supervisor Shelley gave and update on Southern lowa Trolley and E911.

COVID-19 UPDATES AND DISCUSSION: The Board discussed remaining to operate the same way we have been. There hasn't been any further exposure in the courthouse. There has been some exposure at secondary roads and three employees are currently quarantined.
