GHI chose to not place a bid for 2021. Moved by Homan and seconded by Wedemeyer to approve the trash collection bid from Grantham Sanitation for 2021. Approved.

ICAP BOARD OF DIRECTORS BALLOT: Moved by Homan and seconded by Hoadley to vote for incumbents Tom Roth for City Seat and Dave Hageman for County Seat for the ICAP Board of Directors. Approved.

MANURE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE: Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Shelley to acknowledge receipt of the manure management plan update from Marton/Glenview Finisher Farm located in Union County. Approved.

MIDWEST PARTNERSHIP: Supervisor Wedemeyer stated that he had been included in a conference call with Greater Des Moines Partnership and Midwest Partnership about a broadband study. Wedemeyer believes this would be a great opportunity for the region with very little cost to the County. Sarah Gomez, Midwest Partnership stated that broadband has been an issue for a long time and the partnership has found a company that can do the broadband study and see what can be done for the region and its rural areas. Mike Colwell, Greater Des Moines Partnership and Ken Demlow, HR Green, gave a presentation to the Board on what information would be gathered and how it would be used to improve the County's broadband and connectivity. The overall cost for the region would be \$338,940, with the County's share being \$1,963 which is based on our population. Many other counties in the region have already committed to the project and they are hoping the other counties within the region can make a decision by the end of November. The Board discussed the County's current issues with broadband and voiced their support for the project. Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Hoadley to move forward with the project and for the County to pay its portion of the project costs of \$1.963. Approved. Janelle Schneider and Brenda Wallace entered at 9:18 a.m.

AUDITOR: FY20 Urban Renewal (TIF) Annual Report - Auditor Berg discussed the FY20 Urban Renewal Annual Report with the Board. Moved by Shelley and seconded by Homan to approve and to sign the FY20 Urban Renewal/TIF Annual Report and instruct the Auditor to file with State. Approved. FY20 GAAP Financial Report - Auditor Berg stated that she was unable to complete this in time for the meeting and that she will bring it back to the Board next week.

COVID-19 UPDATES & DISCUSSION: Mask Policy - Auditor Berg updated the Board on the County's current COVID situation and presented a mask wearing policy. The policy states that any person, including employees, entering the courthouse or present in any other administrative office of Adair County must wear a mask unless an employee is alone in his/her designated office. This policy lines up with the guidance that has been provided by our local public health and Governor Reynolds. Moved by Shelley and seconded by Hoadley to approve and for the chair to sign the mask wearing policy. Approved.
