GIS SHAPEFILE: Auditor Berg stated that Assessor Jensen verified that the County would not be charged the fee for the GIS Shapefile for the City of Stuart's project. Moved by Shelley and seconded by Walker to waive the fee gWorks who requested a GIS Shapefile for a project for the City of Stuart. Approved.

PARTIALLY SELF-FUNDED MEDICAL PLAN AGREEMENT: Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Walker for the chair to sign the partially self-funded medical plan agreement with Auxiant. Approved.

NEXTERA ENERGY: Bo McGee, NextEra Energy, gave an update on the Heartland Divide II Wind Project in Audubon County with transmission lines running through Adair County to the transmission station on Fallow Avenue. McGee stated that all easements are 100% voluntary and that Adair County landowners have been great to work with. Construction on the project will start in April 2021 and the completion date is set in November of 2021. McGee encouraged individuals to check out the Heartland Divide II Wind project website and Facebook page and to reach out if anyone had any questions or concerns. McGee exited at 9:15 a.m.

COVID-19 UPDATES & DISCUSSION: The Board discussed receiving Local Government COVID Relief Grant money and using that money to help the board of health and other entities that have been affected by the coronavirus. Moved by Twombly and seconded by Wedemeyer to give \$10,000 to Public Health and ask for an itemized list on what the money was spent on. Approved. A budget amendment will be needed to disburse this money.

ENGINEER: Front Page – Moved by Hoadley and seconded by Walker to sign the Front Page for the FY21 Rock Contract plans for FMC001(114)—55-01. Approved. ROW Contracts – Moved by Wedemeyer and seconded by Twombly to approve the right-of-way contract with Christofferson Family Trust. Approved. Moved by Shelley and seconded by Walker to approve the right-of-way contract with Ethan Shetler. Approved. **Final Voucher** – Moved by Twombly and seconded by Hoadley to sign the final voucher for G-61 Grading Project LFM-LGG61—7X-01 with JB Holland. Approved. **Budget Discussion** – Kauffman and the Board discussed the TIF project options that were sent to the Board last week. The Board was in favor of option 3 with several smaller projects that would allow the County to bond under the \$5,000,000. Hoadley stated that she would like the Henry A. Wallace birthplace to be listed in the projects. It was determined that it would be best to group that project with the Henry A. Wallace Road project and Kauffman will plan to bond for that project in a couple years. Kauffman stated that he would like to add the design cost of \$70,000 to the LOST budget for the BROS SWAP bridge project that the Board has discussed interest in doing. **Report of Maintenance & Activities** – Kauffman gave an update on the following projects: Hungry Canyons meeting and snow removal.
