**COVID-19 UPDATES & DISCUSSION:** Supervisor Shelly asked that the mask signs be changed to state that masks were recommended and not required. The Board discussed the American Rescue Plan Act funding. Auditor Berg has an agreement for the Board to sign next week and once that is submitted, the County should receive the funds in about a week. There are ongoing changes being made to how the funding can be used and the final interim rule from Department of Treasury will not be finalized until after July 16, 2021.
