## November 9, 2021

Board members present for regular session at 9:00 a.m. were: Shelley, Twombly, and Walker. Hoadley joined via conference phone. Wedemeyer was absent.

Also present: Mandy Berg and Janelle Schneider. Jennifer Nichols – Atlantic News Telegraph and Travis Huss joined via conference phone.

All motions were approved unanimously unless noted otherwise.

Due to heightened public health risk from the coronavirus outbreak, the Board Meeting was held via conference call pursuant to Iowa Code section 21.8 along with in-person public attendance in the boardroom.

**MINUTES:** Moved by Walker and seconded byTwombly to approve the minutes from November 3, 2021. Approved. Matt Wedemeyer joined via conference phone at 9:03 a.m.

**COVID-19 UPDATES & DISCUSSION:** The Adair County Medical Clinic is currently making appointments for booster shots. No other updates were discussed. Rich Wallace, Courthouse Maintenance, entered at 9:04 a.m.

**CHRISTMAS DECORATIONS IN COURTYARD:** Stacie Eshelman, Greenfield Chamber entered at 9:06 a.m. Eshelman stated that the Greenfield Business Women sell wreaths to raise money and they have recently purchased some Christmas decorations that they would like to display in the Courthouse Courtyard. GMU and the Lions Club would help with putting these decorations up. Supervisor Hoadley stated her concerns with causing more work for Wallace when removing snow and keeping sidewalks cleared and asked if they would provide liability insurance coverage. Eshelman stated that the Chamber already carries insurance that covers the courtyard for their events. Wallace stated that his biggest concern was having the utility boxes above the ground and the cords running over sidewalks. This would be a concern during snow removal and for people walking in the courtyard. Eshelman presented a plan that Carol Woosley had drawn up for locations of the decorations. Supervisor Twombly stated that they should get permission from the City of Greenfield to allow Wallace to blow snow into the street at those locations to avoid and damage to the decorations and that the City should flag the utility boxes. Twombly doesn't see it as a problem as long as there is insurance in place for the public or damage from snow removal and that they don't expect the County to upkeep them. Eshelman stated that they would have the decorations taken down before the new year. Moved by Twombly and seconded by Walker to allow the Christmas decorations to be put up in the Courthouse Courtyard with proof of insurance and no liability to the County, with the approval of snow being blown into the street during that time, and with the City to use flags to mark the utility box sites. Approved. Wallace and Eshelman exited at 9:17 a.m.
