Moved by Twombly and seconded by Hoadley to close the public hearing at 9:32 a.m. Johnsons exited at 9:34 a.m. Moved by Hoadley and seconded by Walker to approve **Resolution #2022-40** – Whereas, A public hearing was conducted on April 20, 2022, at 9:30 AM following publication and service of notice as required by law on the proposed vacation and closure of a portion of County Secondary Road, described as follows: That portion of "140th St.", established July 7th, 1875 (See Road Record Book 1, page 383), commencing at the northeast corner of Section 25, T77N, R30W, thence running west on the Section line through Townships T77N, R30W and T77N, R31W to the northwest corner of Section 26, T77N ,R31W. Whereas, No objections have been received, either in writing or by persons present. Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Adair County Board of Supervisors that the section of this road from the northeast corner of Section 30, Township 77 North, Range 30 West of the 5th P.M., running west on the Section line to the northwest corner of Section 28 of Township 77 North, Range 30 West of the 5th P.M., running west on the Section line to the northwest corner of Section 28 of Township 77 North, Range 30 West of the 5th P.M. shall remain open and is not vacated.
