ICAP INSURANCE RENEWAL: Auditor Berg presented the Iowa Communities Assurance Pool tort liability Insurance Renewal. Moved by Twombly and seconded by Hoadley to for the vice-chair to sign the ICAP Insurance Renewal. Approved.

AUDITOR – COUNTY MILEAGE RATE: Auditor Berg stated with rising gas prices that the IRS Standard Mileage Rate was increasing to \$0.625/mile starting July 1, 2022. Currently, the County reimburses mileage for most County employees at \$0.10 below the IRS standard mileage rate with the current County rate being paid at \$0.46/mile. Berg stated she would like to see all employees receive at least the IRS mileage rate going forward which would require a new resolution to be passed. Berg's main concern today is with her election workers' mileage for the Primary Election. The rate currently being paid will not even cover the gas for the worker's mileage. Berg stated that her election workers are vital to running an election and believes their mileage rate should be adjusted to the new IRS rate. Moved by Shelley and seconded by Twombly to allow the election workers to be reimbursed using the new IRS standard mileage rate of \$0.625/mile. The Board discussed the issue more with Engineer Kauffman stating that he believes the change should be for all County employees. The Board discussed Auditor Berg drawing up a new Travel Policy Resolution for next week that would increase the mileage rate for all County employees effective June 1, 2022 to include the election workers' mileage. Supervisor Shelley withdrew his previous motion and the resolution will be put on next week's agenda.

ENGINEER: Sign Agreement – Moved by Shelley and seconded by Twombly for the Vice-Chair to sign the Federal-Aid SWAP funding agreement for BROS-SWAP-C0001(118)—SE-01. Approved. Kauffman stated that this project would be SWAP funded at 100%. **Budget Discussion** – Kauffman discussed some concerns he had with future budgets with the rising costs of fuel, labor, rock, supplies, insurance, IT, etc. Kauffman believes his current budget can handle the increase, but if costs keep going up, the Board may have to look at options to increase funds to secondary roads on the maintenance side of things, which TIF and LOST revenue does not cover, starting in FY24. Kauffman distributed a spreadsheet showing the percentage changes of rock and wages versus the amount of property taxes that have been transferred to the secondary road fund. Since FY2016, the property tax transfer has decreased by 2.87% while rock has increased 43.59% and wages 27%. **Activities & Maintenance Report** – Kauffman gave an update on the following projects: the contractor for Airport Road, lowa Street, and Lakeview Road has been delayed by a week and working on G61 placing rock.
