AUDITOR – NEW HIRE: Moved by Hoadley and seconded by Baier to approve the hire of Nathan Reed as the Auditor's Elections and Real Estate Deputy at a starting salary of 68% of the Auditors Salary for \$46,216.55. Approved. Auditor Berg stated that his tentative start date would be August 30th, 2023 and is dependent on the preemployment screenings. Gwen Johnston, John Schildberg III, and Lee Ashmore entered at 9:04 a.m.

VETERANS' AFFAIRS: VA Administrator – John Schildberg III, VA Commissioner, informed the Board that they appointed Gwen Johnston as the Administrator effective August 1, 2023 with a pay rate of \$21.49/hour, which is the same as former Administrator Duane Avey. Schildberg also discussed Avey filling in for Johnston when she has trainings in order to talk with the Veterans and make appointments with Johnston. **VA Annual Report** – Gwen Johnston, VA Administrator, discussed the FY23 Veterans' Affairs Annual Report. Johnston stated that they have been busy with the PACT Act deadline approaching and transportation of veterans with those appointments. The VA still only has two drivers, so they are looking to find another driver. They have stepped up their outreach and have gotten good feedback by attending parades, the fair, and their annual event at the fairgrounds. Johnston attended the National schooling via Zoom. Johnston state that they would like to change their office hours in order to be open an evening during the week, so their Wednesday hours will change to be open from noon to 6:00 p.m. The VA will be getting a vehicle from the State VA to haul vets and they are still looking for a secure parking spot. The Board discussed the vehicle and how the drivers would then be paid, since they currently only receive mileage for driving their personal vehicles. Johnston stated that they also a TV in the office for veterans to attend appeals instead of having to be transported to Des Moines. Johnston, Schildberg, and Ashmore exited at 9:23 a.m.
