**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN TO THE ELIGIBLE VOTERS OF ADAIR COUNTY, IOWA, THAT THE COMBINED CITY & SCHOOL ELECTION WILL BE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2019**

The polls for said election will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. Voters must vote in their precinct of residence. Please read this notice carefully to determine your correct voting location. Voting locations have changed for some voters. **District 2NE\*\*** – Stuart Recreational Center, 323 SW 2<sup>nd</sup> St, Stuart IA (For voters residing in Stuart, Lincoln, Jefferson E of State Hwy 25, Grove, Harrison, Lee N of State Hwy 92, & Grand River N of State Hwy 92)

**District 3SW\*\*\*** – Fontanelle Community Building, 224 3<sup>rd</sup> St, Fontanelle IA (For voters residing in Jackson, Bridgewater, Washington, Fontanelle, Summerset S of State Hwy 92 & Sec 15, 16, 17, & 18 Summerset S of 240<sup>th</sup> St, & Richland)

**District 4SE\*\*\*\*** – Orient United Methodist Church, 124 S Maple St, Orient IA (For voters residing in Lee S of State Hwy 92, Grand River S of State Hwy 92, Orient City, Orient Twp, Union, Greenfield Twp S of State Hwy 92, & SE Greenfield City)

**District 5GF** – Adair County Health & Fitness Center, 202 N Townline Rd, Greenfield IA (For voters residing in SW & N Greenfield City & Greenfield Twp N of State Hwy 92)

**\*Notice of polling place change:** All portions of the 1NW District have been consolidated for this election, and voters in this district will vote at Adair City Hall, 320 Audubon St, Adair IA.

**\*\*Notice of polling place change:** All portions of the 2NE District have been consolidated for this election, and voters in this district will vote at the Stuart Recreational Center, 323 SW 2<sup>nd</sup> St, Stuart IA.

**\*\*\*Notice of polling place change:** All portions of the 3SW District have been consolidated for this election, and voters in this district will vote at the Fontanelle Community Building, 224 3<sup>rd</sup> St, Fontanelle IA.

**\*\*\*\*Notice of polling place change:** All portions of the 4SE District have been consolidated for this election, and voters in this district will vote at the Orient United Methodist Church, 124 S Maple St, Orient IA.

**Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the county auditor's office by 12:00 p.m. (noon), November 12, 2019. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. At which election all of the registered voters of said County are hereby notified to appear at said time and place. Each voter must vote at the polling place of the respective voting precinct in which such voter resides.
