The Primary Election will be Tuesday, June 2, 2020. Voter pre-registration deadline is 5:00 p.m. Friday, May 22, 2020. Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on election day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the Auditor's Office by 12:00 p.m. (noon), June 9, 2020. Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification. Voters may request an absentee ballot from the Auditor's Office. Voters may vote in the office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, beginning May 4, 2020 or they may request a ballot be mailed to them. The deadline to request an absentee ballot be mailed is 5:00 p.m. Friday, May 22, 2020. The last day to vote absentee in the Auditor's Office is Monday, June 1, 2020 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Polls will open from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Election Day June 2, 2020.

Due to the coronavirus both Iowa Secretary of State, Paul Pate and Adair County Auditor, Mandy Berg are strongly encouraging voters to vote-by-mail. The first day absentee ballots can be mailed is Thursday, April 23, 2020. If you have any questions regarding voting absentee by mail please contact the Auditor's Office at (641) 743-2546.
