GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. NOT qualified for continuous movement (night time) - May only operate from 30 minutes prior to sunrise until 30 minutes after sunset.
2. See General Provisions for escort requirement for over width vehicles.
3. Over dimensional signs and flags must be displayed on all overdimensional loads over $75^{\prime}$ long or over $8^{\prime} 6$ " wide or over $14^{\prime} 4$ " high.
4. May have a gross weight not to exceed 46,000 lbs. on a single tandem axle of the of the truck tractor and a gross weight not to exceed $46,000 \mathrm{lbs}$. on a single tandem axle the trailer only. No single axles of the tandem group may exceed 24,000 lbs.
5. Centerline all bridges at 5 mph .
6. Load must slow or stop when necessary to avoid approaching traffic when centerlining.
7. Amber revolving light/ strobe light with 360 -degree visibility required on towing unit for entire route.

- Must carry copy of permit and general provisions dated 01-2019 and comply with them.
- Speed limit: maximum posted limits unless otherwise specified on permit.
- Road must be clear of ice and snow and visibility must be at least $1 / 4$ mile.
- Hazardous materials must be transported in compliance with applicable federal regulations.
